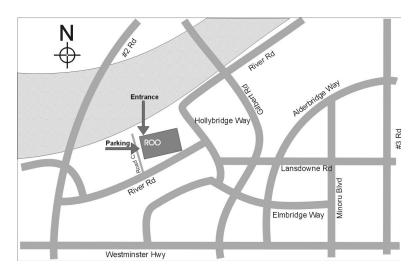


- 8am to 4pm
